



Effective August, 28, 2008, Taiga Building Products, at its Milton distribution centre, has been certified for FSC Chain-of-Custody and Controlled Wood standards by the SmartWood program of the Rainforest Alliance.

Taiga Building Products, Milton, Ontario, distribution centre, will endeavour to utilize their best efforts to avoid trading and sourcing wood or wood fibre from controversial categories as listed in the FSC Standard for Controlled Wood. These include:

- 1) illegally harvested wood
- 2) wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights
- 3) wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities
- 4) wood harvested in forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use
- 5) wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted

Taiga Building Products has taken the necessary steps to properly train and educate specific company personnel and implement the required procedures as outlined in the FSC Chain of Custody Documented Control System and the FSC Controlled Wood Documented Control System.

Taiga Building Products has been audited by the Rainforest Alliance/Smartwood certification body and is certified as a FSC Chain of Custody distributor.
